Halloween Bookmarkers Instructions

Supplies needed: scissors, glue, colored construction paper, contact paper.

This is a fun and simple project for the young and old alike. For young children, prepare this project the night before by cutting out the patterns and using them to cut the colored construction paper. This way the children (child) can glue the prepared bookmarks and add further embellishments if they desire. Older children (and us adults) can cut and use the patterns themselves.

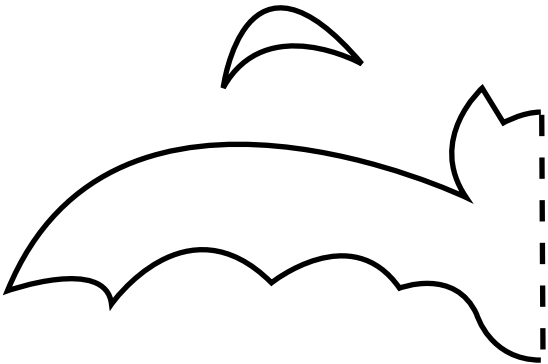
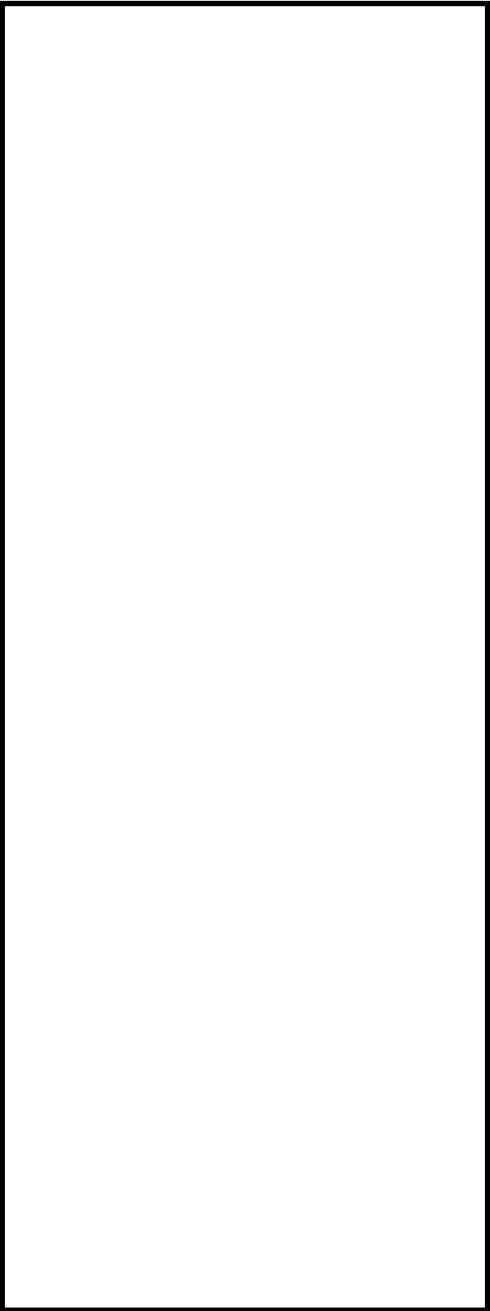
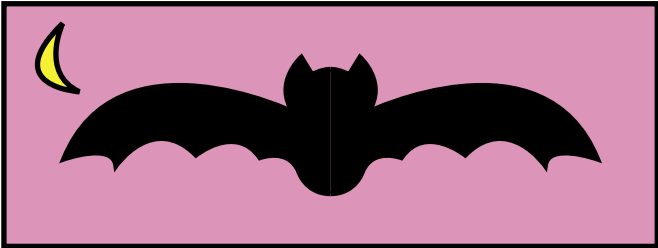
Glue sticks are recommended. They take a shorter time to dry and are less messy than regular bottled glue.

On the backs of the bookmarkers, I have my children write "To: (name)" and "From: (their name)". This way they can hand the bookmarkers out as gifts to family and friends.

To help preserve the bookmarkers, I used contact paper (available at some craft and office supply stores) on both sides. Contact paper is generally cheap and needs to be applied by an adult or someone with steady hands. If you own a laminator, all the better!

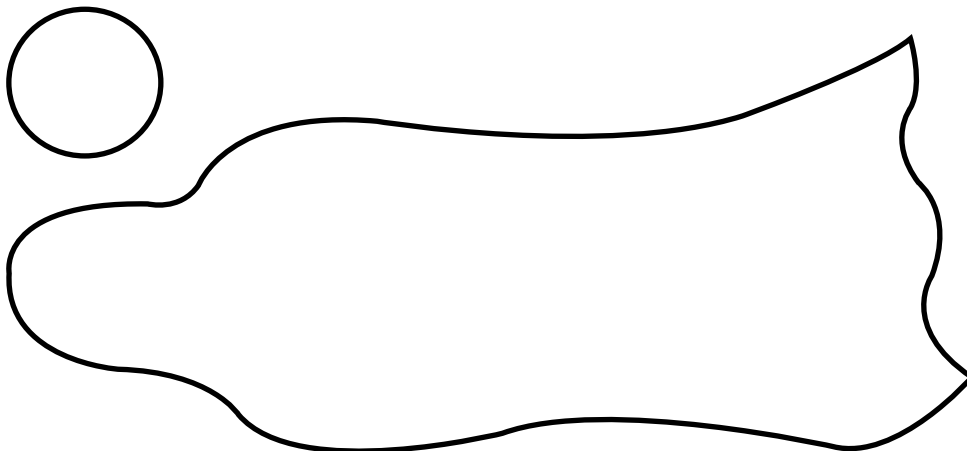
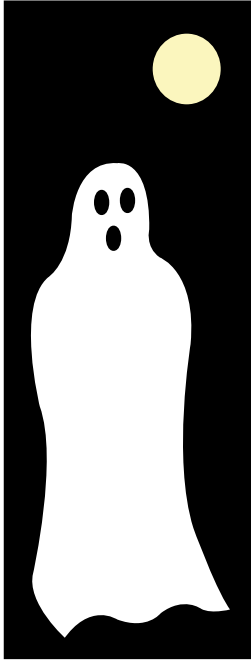
My children and I spent hour making these bookmarkers yesterday (9/9/02) and we had a wonderful time. We hope the same for you.

Bat and Crescent Moon Bookmarker



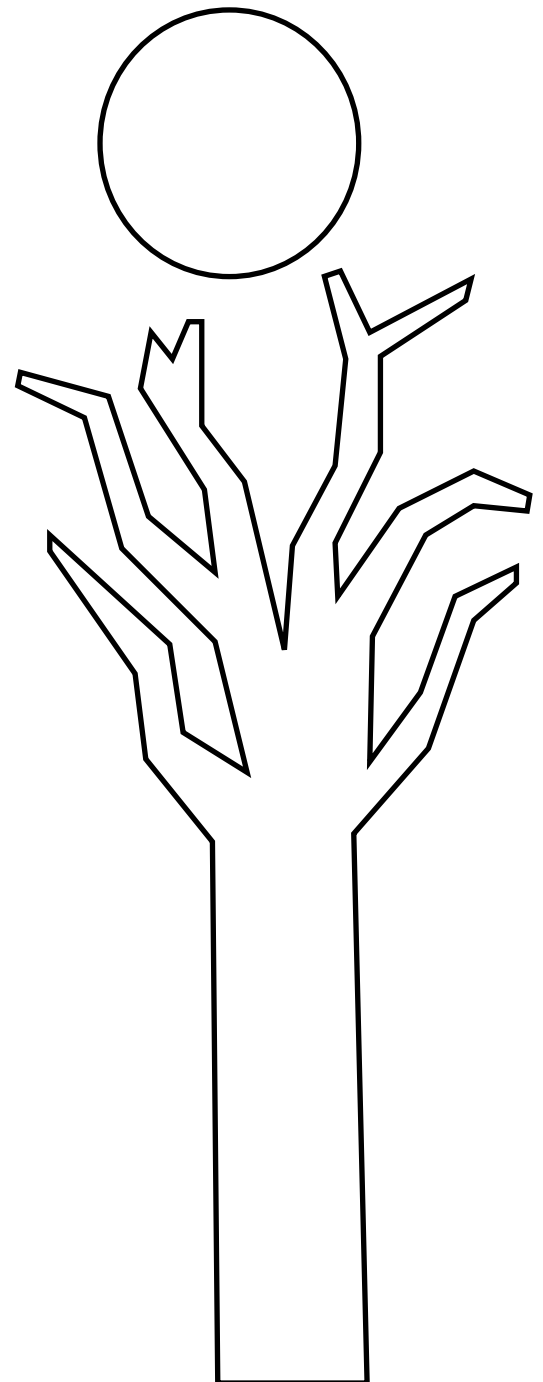
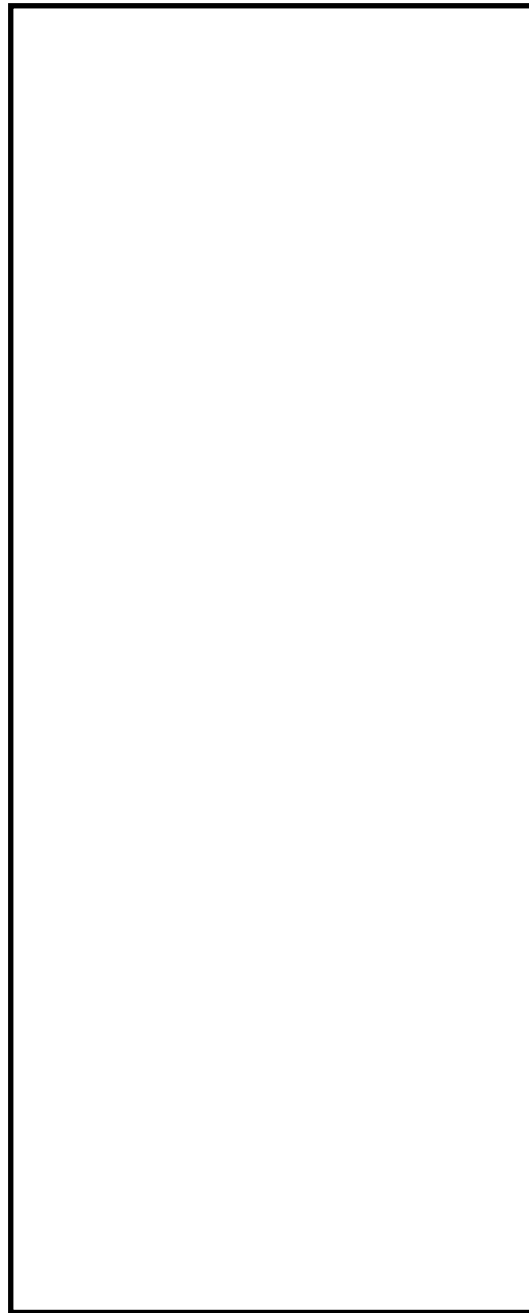
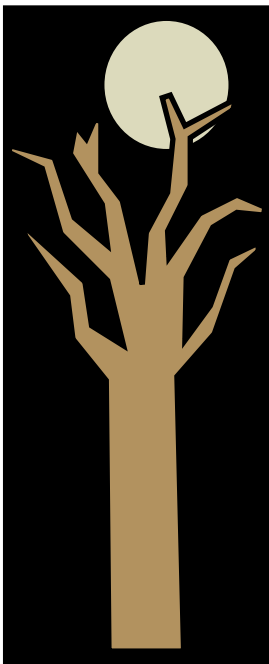
Ghost and Full Moon Bookmarker
