Winter

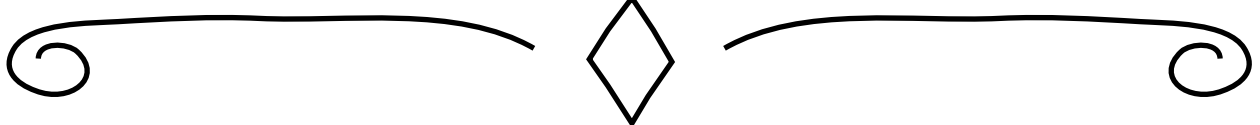
Winter is the time for waiting,

And garden planting has begun.

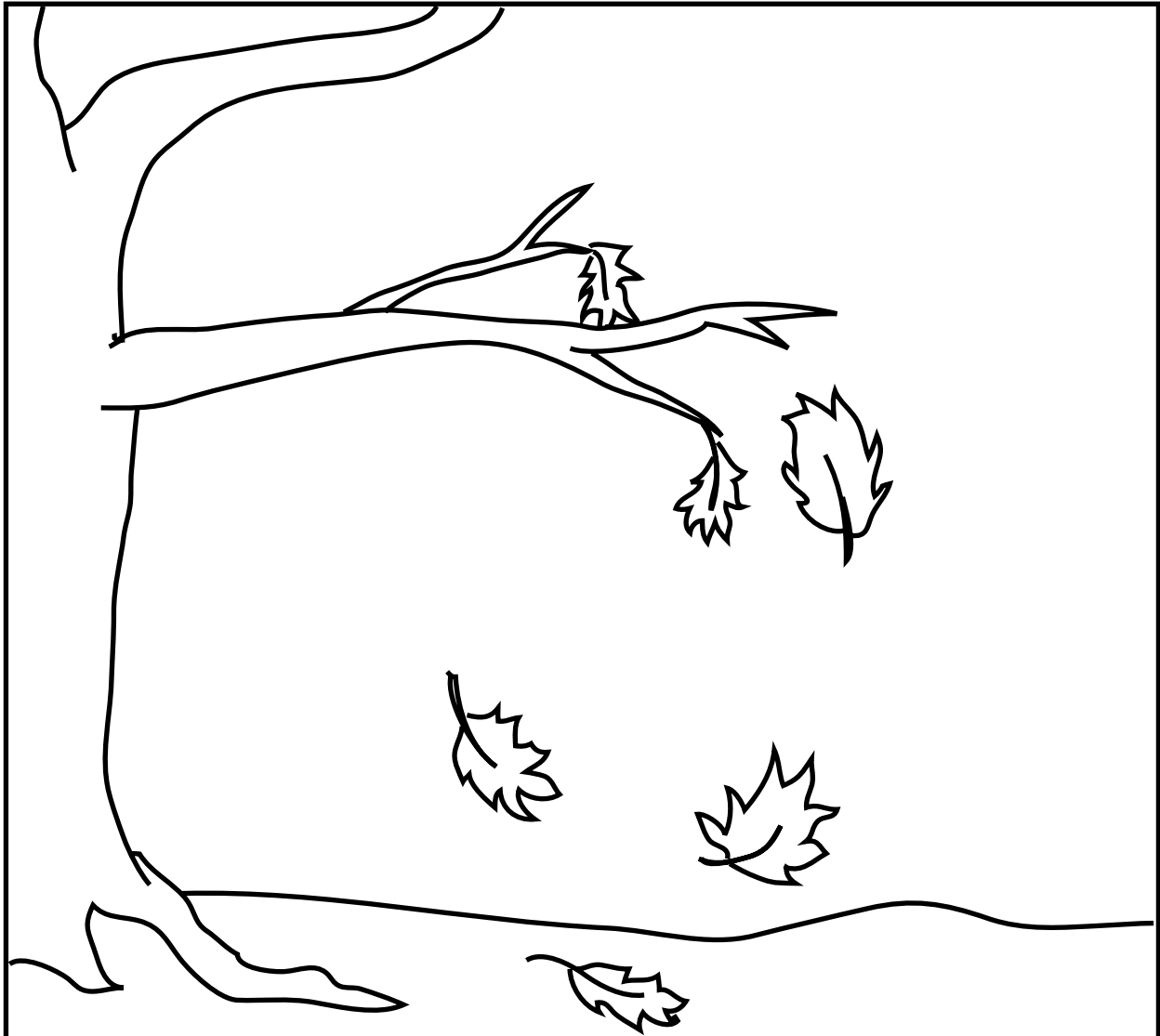




Summer
